Rosaline and Alan Barron, our two Israel Bond honorees, both grew up in Chelsea. Ros's parents, Solomon and Lenke Zam, were Holocaust survivors who survived personal ravages in Poland and Czechoslovakia. Solomon's first act after the war was to create a Hebrew school for Polish Jewish children who survived the war. Ros is a former president of One Generation After, an organization of children of survivors. She received her MD at Johns Hopkins after obtaining a degree in biochemistry at Harvard. Besides her work as a gastroenterologist in Cambridge for the last 22 years she is a clinical instructor at Harvard Medical School. Alan, a graduate of Bowdoin College and Tufts Medical School, is a Primary Care/Internal Medicine specialist, with offices in Belmont, Watertown Cambridge and Somerville. He has a long tenure as an attending physician at Mt. Auburn Hospital and is the Medical Director at Emerson Village. Alan is on the faculty of Harvard Medical School and is active in the Massachusetts Medical Society and the American College of Physicians.

Both Alan and Ros have profiles of leadership at Temple Emeth. Alan has served on the finance, cemetery, investment and school committees. He completed 8 years as a synagogue vice president, and continues as an active Brotherhood member.

They have been lifelong supporters of Israel and have just returned from a two week visit. As part of their work with the Friends of the Israel Defense Forces, they sponsor an annual scholarship to cover a soldier's college tuition. They are also active supporters of Combined Jewish Philanthropies.

In addition to their busy professional lives, Ros and Alan are raising three wonderful children with strong Jewish identities. Rebecca is currently at Tufts Medical School, Shelley is a junior at Bowdoin College and Joshua is at Newton South High School. All three are graduates of the Solomon Schechter School and the girls are graduates of Gann Academy.
